Santa

Step-by-Step Instructions

CANVAS

Step 1: Start with a wide flat brush and light blue paint, fill in the entire background behind Santa. While the paint is still wet, add white and light blue to the center of the background, mixing with the wet paint. Add gold to some areas, if desired.

Step 2: Clean your brush and fill Santa's hat with red paint.

Step 3: With a medium round brush, paint the star gold.

Step 4: With a medium or small round brush, paint Santa's skin. Once filled in, pick a slightly darker color to add shadow to the left side of his face.

Step 5: Use a large flat brush and a mix of white and gold paint, fill in Santa's beard and the fur of his hat. Make sure your brush strokes follow the direction of the hair and layer the two colors to create depth. Use circular strokes when filling in his hat fur.

Step 6: With the same brush and a little bit of turquoise paint, use the thin edge of the brush and add some turquoise streaks in his hair. Add turquoise to Santa's hat and star too.

Step 7: Add some texture to the red part of Santa's hat with gold paint.



Step 8: Using either a large flat brush and/or a small round brush, outline all of the black lines on Santa's beard, hat, face, and star. Repeat with white paint.

Step 9: With a small liner brush, fill in the iris of Santa's eye with black and add a highlight with white.

Step 10: Let dry.

Step 11: With your finger or medium round brush, add clear glitter paint to Santa's hat and star, or wherever you desire. Be sure to clean the brush when you are done!

Step 12: Using your finger, dab Snow-Tex to areas on Santa's beard and the fur of his hat.
