

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

Start by painting the background pretty quickly with white, blue, and light green paint. At the bottom, paint with blue and white blended into the background. Slowly add green and white as you paint upward.

STEP 2

With a light brown and white mixed together, paint in the Reindeer's mouth and around his nose. Paint in the center part of the neck, ears, the hair on the left side of his face, and under the left eye and cheek.



STEP 3

With a reddish brown, paint in the Reindeer's antlers, the main part of his face, under his cheek, the lower part of his neck, and a thin line in the ears. With dark brown, fill in the middle of the ears, the center of his face, and the inside of the neck. Double check you haven't missed any areas.

STEP 4

With a small brush, fill in the eyes and nose black. Then with a liner brush, outline the Reindeer's features. You can also use a paint pen.

STEP 5

Add some highlights with yellow paint and a small brush in the antlers, ears, and all around the face and neck. Do the same step with white paint. Don't forget the nose and mouth.

STEP 6

Add two dots and a small swish of white highlights in the eyes. Then, dot in some white falling snow in the background.

STEP 7

Mix green, blue, and white and add some touches around the face and ears.

STEP 8

Now for the marshmallows! With a variety of sizes, dip them into the paint, twist, and pull. Repeat this step with green, yellow, and red. Add any other detial you like. **Enjoy!**
