

### **STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS**

## **STEP 1**

With a 1" flat brush and some white and blue paint, paint the background. Clean off your brush and paint the fence brown.

#### **STEP 2**

With a medium round brush, paint the Donkey's hat red.

# STEP 3

Paint the Donkey's body, face, and outer part of his ears black. Don't forget the small section under the fence. Paint in an exaggerated eyebrow shape above his eyes. Then, add a few streaks of white to make the fur look fluffy.



With a small brush, paint the jaw line with white paint. Then, blend it into the black fur. Mix a little bit of black and white paint to make light gray and paint in the ears.

#### **STEP 5**

With a small brush, paint the Donkey's eyes and nostrils with black paint. Paint his lower lip light gray and the area between his nostrils gray.



## **STEP 6**

Next, paint his muzzle and the area around his eyes white (or leave it the white of the canvas). Add touches of white to the center of the ears, the hat trim, and puff. Don't forget the highlights in the eyes. Blob in the piles of snow on the fence and stamp in some white dots as falling snow.

## STEP 7

With a black marker or tiny brush, outline the fence, snow piles, around the hat, and the Donkey's muzzle.



Add any extra touches. Enjoy!
